




Quick Guide to Searching the Data

GO TO: www.childhealthdata.org


- You will see the homepage of the Data Resource Center for Child and Adolescent Health website.
- Choose the survey data you are interested in searching. *CLICK* on either the National Survey of Children's Health or the National Survey of Children With Special Health Care Needs in the middle of page.

BEGIN a DATA SEARCH

CLICK on the **Search the Data** button in the middle of the page or **Start Data Query** on the left side of web page. Either action takes you directly to the start of the interactive data query.

- Select a focus area for your search. *CLICK* on 
- There are 3 basic steps to conducting a data query. The "Recipe" diagram below outlines this process — plus the state-to-state comparison option.

START a NEW QUERY or CHANGE SEARCH AREAS

CLICK on  in the upper right hand corner of a data results screen or **Start Data Query** on the left hand side of the web page.

SELECT a NEW TOPIC or QUESTION

CLICK on  or  in the upper right corner of a data results screen.

STEP 1

A) SELECT GEOGRAPHIC AREA
(e.g. Nationwide, State or HRSA region)
B) SELECT a TOPIC to search
C) Click on **NEXT**

A) SELECT a QUESTION
within topic area
B) Click **NEXT** to view
results for question

STEP 3

Click on

age, gender, race, type
of special need, etc.
